1. The Parish Council has submitted its official response to the fire station closure following the consultation.
2. The information and details of the lease have been provided to the solicitor and are currently awaiting confirmation.
3. The defibrillator has now been hardwired into the Mega Hut. An electrician has investigated further, and at present everything appears to be working correctly.
4. The allotment gates have been reopened, and the track specification is currently under consideration.
5. Repairs to the Maiden Newton clock are scheduled to take place around 24th April.
6. The bollard quote will be discussed further on the agenda following advice from Highways.
7. The Finance meeting has been scheduled for 30th April.
8. A litter pick was carried out on 22nd March; however, turnout was quite low this year, so alternative dates may be considered in future.
